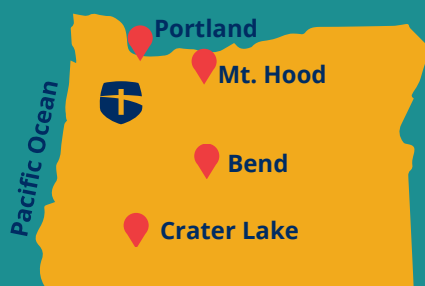

- Complete and submit the following items:
 1. Application (www.corban.edu)
 2. Personal Faith Statement
 3. SAT (*min.* 990), ACT (*min.* 19), or CLT (*min.* 64) scores
 4. Cumulative, unweighted high school GPA (*min.* 2.7)
 5. Official college transcripts (*if applicable*)
